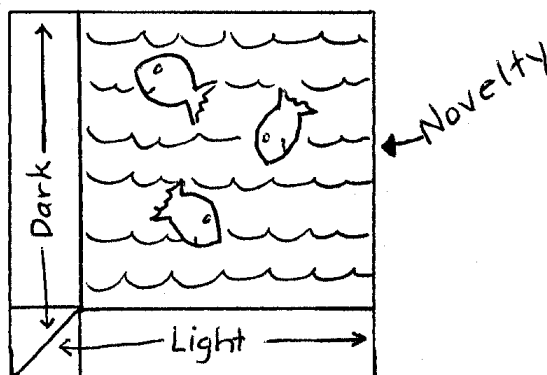


EASY ATTIC WINDOW for Donation Quilt
Unfinished size 7 1/2" square



Novelty Fabric (this is what you will look at in the window)

Cut 1...6 1/2" square

Coordinating Light Fabric

Cut 1...2 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Cut 1...2 7/8" square Cut 2...cut diagonally from corner to corner (will use only 1 piece)

Coordinating Dark Fabric

Cut 1...2 1/2" x 6 1/2"

Cut 1...2 7/8" square Cut 2...cut diagonally from corner to corner (will use only 1 piece)

Steps

1. Sew one 2 1/2 x 6 1/2 **dark** rectangle to **left side** of window square. (press to square)
2. Sew one light and one dark triangle together along the diagonal to make a square.
3. Sew small square to **left end** of 2 1/2 x 6 1/2 **light** rectangle, matching colors accordingly **light to light**. See diagram above. Press toward square.
4. Sew bottom window ledge to top to form attic window, nesting seams.
