

Quilt Block for January 2009 for Members' Raffle
Unfinished Size 9 1/2" square

Color 1...Dark Brown Print

Cut one 3 1/2" x 18" strip

*CUT into five 3 1/2" squares

Cut one 4" x 14" strip

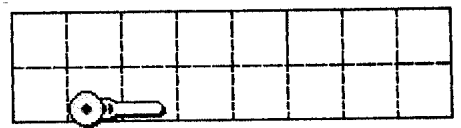
*CUT into eight 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles



Color 2...Light Beige Solid

Cut one 4" x 16" strip

*CUT into sixteen 2" squares

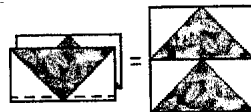


Steps

1. Place a small Color 2 square atop the left end of a Color 1 rectangle. On the back of the small square, lightly mark the diagonal and sew ON this line. Cut off excess seam allowance, leaving 1/4". Press the seam towards the inner triangle. Repeat this with another small square on the other end of the rectangle. Make eight of these units.



2. Now sew the flying geese units together in pairs, using a scant 1/4" seam. Make four units. Press seams towards the upper goose unit.



3. Sew the units together to make rows, and join the rows to make the block. On the top and bottom rows, press the seams towards the outer units. On the middle row, press the seams towards the center square. When joining rows press seams in alternating directions.
