

Buckeye Beauty

This makes a 12" block and is a circa 1929 pattern!

Each block needs six different calicoes and two different cream/tans!



APRIL MEMBER BLOCK of the MONTH

A chance to use up scraps!!!

Cut four 3 1/2" squares, each one a different calico-like print.



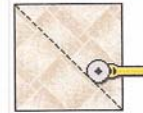
Cut two 6 7/8" squares, each one a different calico-like print. Cut on the diagonal. You will use only one triangle of each color.



Cut four 3 1/2" squares out of a 3 1/2" by 14" cream colored strip.



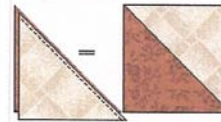
Cut one 6 7/8" square out of a darker cream/tan color. Cut on the diagonal to make two half square triangles.



Sew the squares into two sets of four patches. A calico and cream of top and a cream and calico on the bottom as shown.



Sew one calico triangle to one darker cream/tan colored triangle. Make two squares like this.



Sew the four units together as shown.
